

RESIDENCE/WORK PERMIT

Anyone can submit an application for residence/work permit. The Embassy is obliged to receive the application even if no supporting documentation has been provided. Supporting documentation will normally be beneficial for the application. Applicants are therefore advised to provide the following (additional documentation may be required):

- Two sets of application forms for residence/work permit duly completed with two photos not older than three months**
- Copy of relevant pages of the passport (also previous visas to Schengen)**
- Verified translation and copy of your birth certificate ***
- Verified translation and copy of your ID card ***
- Verified translation and copy of all pages of your Household Registration ***
- Documentation proving change of name (if any) ***
